 - Developed a BIM Project Execution Plan template that is easy to implement and understand by all parties involved.
 - Developed a thorough library of how-to-videos for the Revit Resources site.

 - Using HTML (Meyer) and Share-Point-Server (Teter), I developed company intra-nets that drastically streamlined the process of finding resources on the server(s) (Revit Resources, CAD Resources, Professional Resources, Detail Libraries, Human Resources, etc.).
 - At Teter, I developed a project-specific website for Clovis unified School District to assist with collaboration efforts. Developed interactive 3-D Panoramic views for the site.
 - I was responsible for updating and maintained the hardware and software used within Meyer to run at optimum efficiency.
 - Transitioned Meyer from SBS 2003 server with ISA firewall to new SBS 2011 server with Sonicwall firewall.
 - At Meyer, I created and maintained our firm's website, intranet and FTP server.
